Animals can be dropped off to the clinic from 7.30am Monday to Saturday. When the vets have a chance to assess the animal, we will ring the carer and organise a time to pick the animal up.

Appointment times are not allocated to wildlife animals. They will be admitted by nurses and are assessed when the vets have finished attending to clinic animals. **(All emergency cases will be assessed & treated immediately)**

If you require a specific time to have your animals seen, a normal consult charge will be charged.

Tetanus vaccinations are now given by our nurses, and will be booked in as a nurse consult. All our nurses are trained in giving these injections.
